I got my first Samoyed in 1971 and got involved with obedience. After putting CD's on my first two Samoyeds I got involved in conformation showing. I started handling and was very successful with several of my friend's dogs including campaigning a male Samoyed to the Top Winning Samoyed in Canada with 3 Best in Shows. In 1980 I joined Kathy and Que Sera Samoyeds. Que Sera Samoyeds, in very limited breeding, has bred two Samoyed Club of America #1 Top Winning Bitches and a Samoyed Club of America #2 Top Winning Bitch. We were also the breeder owners of a Samoyed Club of America's National Specialty Grand Futurity Winner. We currently enjoy working our dogs in weight pulls and herding.

I applied to judge for American Kennel Club in 1990 and am now approved for the entire AKC Working Group, Golden Retrievers, Australian Shepherds and German Shepherds. I have judged four Samoyed Regional Specialties in the US, one Samoyed Regional Specialty in Canada and I judged Best of Breed at the Samoyed Club of America's National Specialty. I have judged one Regional Alaskan Malamute Specialty, one Regional Siberian Husky Specialty in the US and the Canadian National Siberian Husky Specialty. In other breeds I have judged one Portuguese Water Dog Regional Specialty, two Boxer Regional Specialties, and two St. Bernard Regional Specialties.

I am a member of several dog related organizations and have served as an Officer or on committees over the years –

I served as the founding President and am the current President of the Samoyed Association of Minneapolis-St. Paul. I have also served as Vice President, Treasurer, Board member and Show Chairman of our Specialties.

I am currently the President of the Minneapolis Kennel Club and also serve as the Trial Chairman for the Obedience and Rally Trials.

I am a member of the Minnesota Dog Judges Association and the Northstar Working Dog Association. I am also a member of the American Dog Show Judges, Inc and the Dog Judges Association of America.

I have served as Vice President, and Board member of the Samoyed Club of America, served as the Judges Education Chairman for 11 years and I'm currently the Chairman of the Illustrated Standard Feasibility Committee. I have also served as the Show Chairman for the National Specialty and have served on 3 other National Specialty Committees.

I applied to judge for American Kennel Club in 1998 and am now approved to judge Samoyeds, Alaskan Malamutes, Siberian Huskies and Australian Shepherds. In Samoyeds I have judged two Samoyed Regional Specialties with entries of 37 and 100 plus one supported show with an entry of 74. In Siberian Huskies I have judged two Regional Specialties with entries of 78 and 59 plus two supported shows with entries of 114 and 62.

I am a member of several dog related organizations and have served as an Officer or on committees over the years –

I served as the founding Vice President and am the current Treasurer of the Samoyed Association of Minneapolis-St. Paul. I have also served as President, Secretary, Board member and Show Chairman of our Specialties.

I am currently the Treasurer of the Minnesota Dog Judges Association and a member of the Minneapolis Kennel Club and the Northstar Working Dog Association. I am also a member of the American Dog Show Judges, Inc and the Dog Judges Association of America.
